- **Mission**: To intervene in and reclaim the lives of 15-1/2 to 18 year olds who are academically at-risk—producing program graduates with the values, life skills, education and self-discipline necessary to succeed as responsible and productive citizens.
- Cooperative program between Idaho Military Division and National Guard Bureau, in contract with JSD #171. Fully State-Accredited Alternative High School.
- The ChalleNGe Program began in 1993 to stem the nation's dropout problem. Idaho's inaugural class was in January 2014.
- Three Phases: 2-week Acclimation, 20-week Residential, and 12-month Post-Residential.

- **Graduates**: 82% successfully moving forward in the 6th month of the Post-Residential Phase and 80% at 12 months.

 - 15% complete the GED
 - 15% receive a high school diploma
 - 10% of graduates enter the Military
 - 20% of Cadets are on probation for a misdemeanor offense.
 - 80% of Cadets are simply struggling in the public schools, with too many distractions in their environment, causing them to be credit deficient. IDYCA offers an environment free of distractions to show Cadets their true potential.


